Pismo Creek Rally

Our Pismo Creek Rally was a great success thanks to Trail Bosses Dick & Lillian Rody and Art & Barbara Valenzuela who provided some 26 members with breakfast consisting of waffles, sausage, omelets-in-bag, home made Belgium waffles, strawberries and much more. The three dinners included pizza, lasagna and chicken. Pismo Creek is private resort, well maintained and within walking distance to the beach. Dave Wickersham was assigned the task of presenting the DDD Award but his investigations disclosed everyone was well behaved so it was held in abeyance until our next rally. Mary Johnson was our under-cover sheriff and managed to collect \$5.00 in fines including \$1.00 from her husband who was late for the membership meeting.

The highlight of our rally was the 100% participation of all attendees to "The Great American Melodrama & Vaudeville" program which kept everyone laughing for at least two hours. They certainly lived up to their reputation of being "The Best Live Entertainment on the Central Coast".

It was also interesting to note that nine of the thirteen rigs had extended stays beyond the scheduled 3-day rally. 
