FMCA National Director's Report



I attended the Governing Board Meeting at FMCA's 98th International Convention on July 18th in Gillette, Wyoming. We took a road trip by car not our RV. Some interesting info was shared. FMCA has had 17 straight positive membership months through June 2018, however, a significant decrease in the total number of chapter members. Chapter membership in 2017 was 24,668 and so far (as of July 2018) is 22,504. FMCA is attracting new members, but they are not joining chapters.

The chapters in the Western United States expressed frustration with the international conventions not being held in their area – with the exception of Oregon - and seem to be concentrated in the Midwest and East Coast. Jon Walker, National President, explained the frustration FMCA has encountered trying to schedule in the Western area. Pomona resulted in a tremendous loss of revenue and they are not having any "luck" trying to have an international rally in Las Vegas. This month's issue of *familyRVing* has an interesting update on the difficult job of scheduling a convention. Difficulties include finding parking for up to 5,000 RVs, adequate exhibitor needs and adequate out-buildings for indoor exhibits and seminars, an arena or grandstand, on-site sewage dumping area or pump-out trucks, exclusive use of the grounds, and offices for many different functions of the event. Also, the community itself needs to have sufficient hotel rooms and rental cars, a major airport within an hour away, an adequate number of campsites in the surrounding area, and buses or other modes of transportation. Many state and local laws are not favorable for exhibitors. The final consideration is cost of the facility.

The next winter convention will once again be in Perry, Georgia from March 13 through 16, 2019. The summer 2019 event


